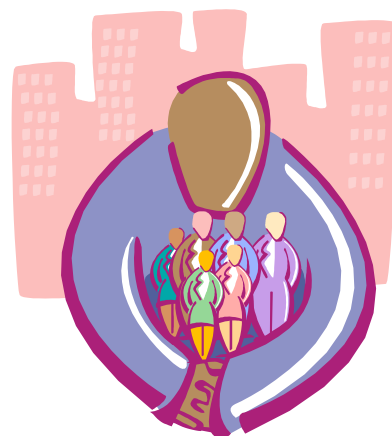


Representing Your Community
